- Exclusive rights to nominate projects for IBBY-Asahi Reading Promotion Award

- Ability to use IBBY logo, name and reputation for promotion of local or regional events
- Each NS is eligible to receive two annual subscriptions to *Bookbird*, paid for by central IBBY

OBLIGATIONS

- Dues must be paid annually – two years of unpaid dues means loss of membership
- Biennial report of activities must be submitted by requested deadline
- Communications from IBBY requesting responses must be answered promptly
- Section must be active in pursuit of IBBY aims and objectives
- Section should make every attempt to have a website and link it to the IBBY website
- Nomination fees for awards and Membership dues must be paid in the current year for the nominations to be eligible.
- Eligibility to nominate for any of the award programmes, IBBY officers and voting rights depends on being a paid-up member in good standing in the current year
- New members must be representative of all sectors in the country's children's book community
- Existing members, when they are not truly representative of the country's children's book community, should initiate a five-year plan for reaching out to all sectors
- Members requesting dues support:
 - Must have a dynamic plan to find support within country
 - Must be representative of all sectors or have a plan to achieve such representation
 - Must cover minimum of 10% of the outstanding dues
 - Can only do so for two consecutive years.
